Sometimes when I am talking to the very young, I have been known to show them the Bible; I ask them to imagine all those words, lots, and lots of them, some very big and hard to understand and then I explain that all of those words can be summed up in one little four-letter word: love.

On this Sunday, which comes between Ascension and Pentecost, we continue to follow the development of the infant Church and return to St. John's theme of God's love for us. Our second reading today, from the first letter of St. John, is so beautiful: each time I encounter it I feel an inner joy since it expresses so clearly and simply the situation "God loved us so much we too should love one another." Simple! I like simple.

At Youth Café on Friday, (that's young people 11-18 who meet fortnightly to share God's love in fun, food, and friendship) during our prayer in a time of silent contemplation, we pondered the love that God has individually for each of us and prayed to be evermore convinced of it so that we can share that love with others. Come to think of it, that's pretty much our Parish Mission Statement.

Maybe this week, as we prepare for the coming of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost, we might each thank the Father for sending his Son into the world and ask him to deepen our love for one another.
